

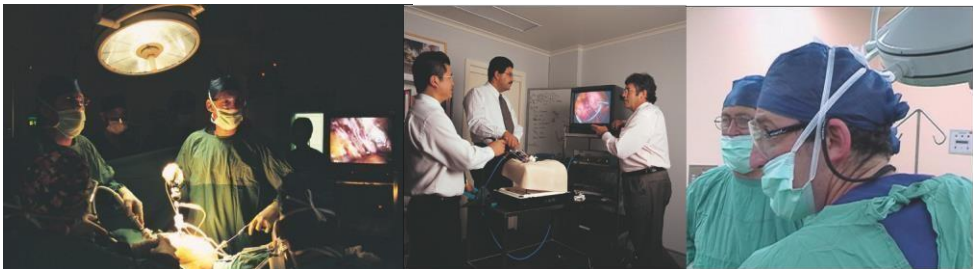

2018 - 2020 courses in advanced gynaecologic laparoscopic surgery

After 20 years of fellowship training and more than 65 workshops, the SWEC team of ten experienced teachers continues to provide fundamental training in advanced laparoscopic surgery.

Over 700 surgeons have completed the week-long SWEC workshop, returning to their practices with new skills and understanding of cutting-edge techniques.

On behalf of the members of the Sydney Women's Endosurgery Centre (SWEC), I would like to invite you to participate in one of our advanced gynaecologic laparoscopic surgery courses.

Very few units in the world can boast of having so many experienced surgeons, with so many different styles, techniques and special interests on its teaching staff.

The workshop involves lectures with the senior anatomist at the University of New South Wales and the SWEC surgeons to describe pure anatomy, surgical anatomy and procedure-based anatomy using computer generated 3D graphics, models, embalmed cadavers and the very lifelike fresh frozen cadavers. This allows us to use this applied surgical anatomy to introduce the new laparoscopic and vaginal mesh pelvic floor reconstructions.

The dry labs and pelvitrainers are state-of-the-art and include synthetic pelvic models so that participants can spend lots of time practising those knots and simulating operations. There is a huge emphasis on curved needle suturing, to complement our focus on total laparoscopic hysterectomy and pelvic floor reconstruction.

The animal laboratory on the last day gives everyone the opportunity to tie those knots and reproduce some of the featured operations on a live specimen under the supervision of our SWEC surgeons.

SWEC has invested heavily in documentation technology which allows us to record, edit and disseminate surgical procedures. Participants receive a full set of live procedures on DVD as part of their course documentation.

WHO SHOULD PARTICIPATE?

- Surgeons with laparoscopic surgical skills should advanced procedure demonstrated, like total laparoscopic hysterectomy and pelvic floor reconstruction.
- Surgeons with basic surgical skills should attend to broaden their repertoire of laparoscopic surgical interventions and learn curved needle suturing.
- Registrars of all grades should attend to be introduced to the minimal access surgical skills that will lead to a proficiency in basic laparoscopic surgery.
- Surgeons who want to be introduced to the new generation of laparoscopic and mesh pelvic floor operations.
- Surgeons who want to do a refresher course in pelvic anatomy and surgical procedure-based anatomy.
