1999- present Treasurer, Sydney Women's Endosurgery Centre (SWEC)

Established in 1995 by Professor Michael Chapman at St George Public Hospital, SWEC was the first advanced gynaecological minimally invasive surgery (MIS) unit in Australia. Dr Rosen was appointed as the inaugural SWEC Fellow the following year (1996-7) and returned from a Fellowship year in the UK in 1999 to take up a position in the unit and at the affiliated public hospital. Since that time, similar MIS units have been established at all major centres in Australia (and ground the world).

SWEC has run an advanced laparoscopic course three times per year since 1996 hosting trainees and fellows who wish to see the latest surgical techniques and improve their surgical skills. It is a research arm of the UNSW through St George Public Hospital and publishes in local and international journals. SWEC Fellows and surgeons also present their research at national and international meetings and have provided major contributions and direction to the Australasian Gynaecological and Surgical Society (AGES).
