Five-day Laparoscopic Course

Who should attend?

- Experienced surgeons wishing to progress their skills in a specialised procedure
- Gynaecologist wishing to know how to progress to a successful practice in Minimally Invasive Gynaecology
- Fellows in Training wanting to see what is possible

Over the Five-Day Course, our guests will see a wide range of benign gynaecological surgery performed laparoscopically and robotically by the SWEC faculty, including:

- Total Laparoscopic Hysterectomy
- Myomectomy
- Sacrocolpopexy and pelvic floor repair
- Burch Colposuspension
- Complex surgery for advanced Endometriosis
- Contained in bag removal of large fibroids/cysts

Lectures will be presented by our SWEC faculty on surgical anatomy, techniques, and peri-operative issues, and our SWEC team will provide instruction on laparoscopic trainers, in knot tying and laparoscopic suturing to allow the visiting surgeon to advance their own surgical practice on return to their base hospital.

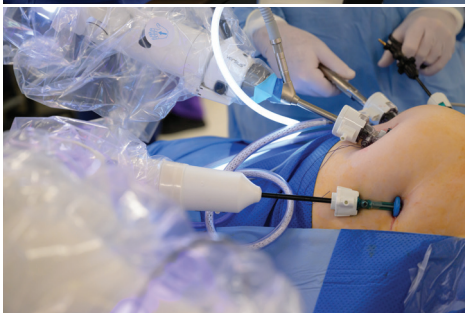
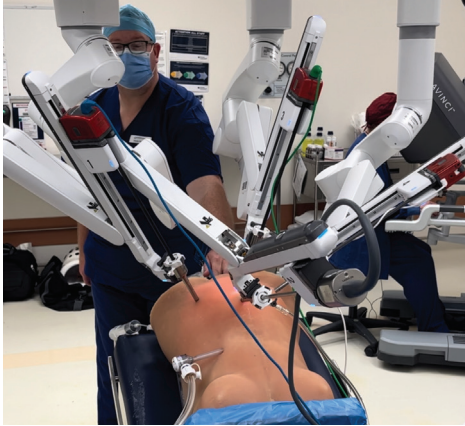
In addition, attendees will have access to representatives from our trade partners throughout the week, to allow seamless transition from our operating rooms to yours.
